Math: In math we will be learning to fluently add and subtract up to one million. We will also be able to identify place values and write in standard, expanded, and word form.
Tests:
8/16/19 1's multiplication fact test. If you did not pass the 0 's, you will take that.

Science: This week we will begin our study of how the Earth and sun cause observable patterns in shadows and in day and night.

Homework is due every day. In math your child should be studying flash cards for 15 minutes a night. The math problems are not due until Friday. Homework counts as $5 \%$ of their grade, but the multiplication tests on Friday will show if your child is studying effectively!
