Math: This week in math we will continue learning how to divide 3 digit by 1 digit, and multiply 2 digit by 2 digit. We will also be learning the difference between multiplicative and additive comparison, as well as solving one step story problems using a variable.

11/26/19 Module 3 Assessment
Science: This week we will be learning how animals adapt to changes in their environment.

Homework is due every day. In math your child should be studying flash cards for 15 minutes a night. The math problems are not due until Friday. Homework counts as $5 \%$ of their grade, but the multiplication tests on Friday will show if your child is studying effectively!

RLA: We will focus on point of view and comparing and contrasting the elements of poem, prose, and play.

Social Studies: We will focus on the war of 1812.
Writing: This week in writing, students will read an informational text and develop a claim or opinion. The students will write an opinion piece and support their claim with text evidence. We will complete our final copy.
